


Clissold Court Recycling



The recycling bins are located at:

- (A) in the open at the end of the garages.
- (B) in the garage – use code 1936 (press 'C' first)



Non-recycling are outside at (B) and (C) →



Please recycle all of the following (*loose, **not in bags** – except**):



- **Aerosols:** Make sure they are empty, but don't squash or pierce them.



- **Cardboard:** boxes and packaging (**please flatten large boxes** and remove any plastic or polystyrene).



- **Cartons:** Milk and fruit juice containers, and tetra-paks (*please squash*)



- **Glass:** Jars and bottles not broken glass, Pyrex, or drinking glasses.



- **Paper:** newspapers, magazines, junk mail, catalogues, telephone directories, envelopes (** please put shredded paper in bags*).



- **Plastic:** including bottles (& tops), margarine containers, ice cream tubs, yoghurt pots, and punnets/trays (e.g. meat, take-aways, fruit/veg)



- **Tins:** food & drink cans, tin foil, ready meal or take away containers.

DO NOT INCLUDE: disposable nappies, polystyrene, foam, sweet & crisp wrappers.

Recycling Food Waste

There are two food waste bins
at **A** and **B**




How does the scheme work?

A small seven litre kitchen caddy is provided for each flat, along with a roll of compostable liners.



1 Place the blue caddy in your kitchen, and line it with a compostable liner.



2 Start collecting your food scraps in the caddy.



3 When the caddy is full, tie the handles of the compostable liner together.



4 Take it down to the food waste container, which is located next to your recycling bins.

What can I put in my kitchen caddy?

Yes

- Fruit
- Raw vegetables
- Eggshells
- Tea bags
- Bread and Pasta
- Cooked meat and fish
- Cooked vegetables
- All cooked food

No

- Raw meat and fish
- Bones
- Plastic bags
- Plastic packaging
- Paper
- Tins and cans
- Glass

The blue caddies and liners are available free from LBH – see below for LBH contact details. (Please Note: the **brown wheely bins** are for **garden waste recycling only**.)

In the **recycling garage**, there are also boxes to recycle:

Batteries, printer ink cartridges, water purifier cartridges, light bulbs and small pieces of scrap metal.
